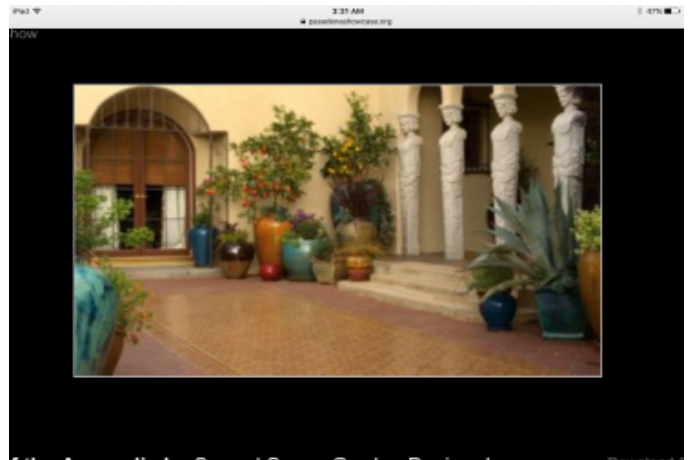
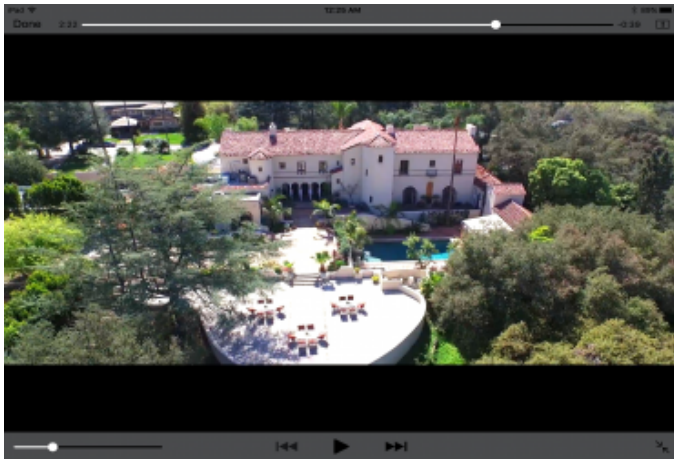

Built in 1922 for George Hanson & designed by renowned architect, Henry Harwood Hewitt, the home was built to be a replica of a Spanish castle with Moorish design. When Hanson began building his residence, he had only one neighbor. When the house was finished it sat in splendid isolation on a ridge overlooking the San Gabriel Mountains. In 1925, the home was the winner of the World Prize in Residential Architecture at the International Exposition of Architecture in New York. In 2008 a multi-year restoration was completed by extraordinary Pasadena Showcase House Designers. This is a rare gem and one of a kind property used recently for various TV series and movies.
